The first three phases of the updating and upgrading of Marian Bergeson Aquatics Center, valued at over \$1.3 million provided by the Newport Mesa Unified School District, the City of Newport Beach, and the community completed to date include:

- Replastered pool and refurbished deck and drainage systems
- Shade structures over bleachers
- New state-of-the-art scoreboard and wireless event management system
- New pool & deck lighting
- Renovated existing building, including team room, offices, work stations/meet management area, & equipment storage

Newport Beach's athletes, students, children, and recreational users need a safe and secure place to change, shower and store their gear. Having a safe and secure facility is long overdue. Phase 4, consisting of a new 3000 square foot restroom/locker/shower building, will exceed \$1,000,000 to design and build. Funds have been committed by the Newport Mesa Unified School District, and a funding request is pending before the Newport Beach City Council. CCAFF's goal is to raise the remaining funds from the community by June 30, 2011. Your generous, tax-deductible contribution will help complete the project.
